

What animals need:

A safe place to live - Animals should have the right type of home, including shelter, space and opportunities to exercise, and somewhere comfortable to rest and hide.

Food and water - Animals need fresh, clean drinking water all the time and should be fed the right amount and type of food to keep them fit and healthy.

To behave normally - Animals should have enough space and the right sort of toys and housing so they can behave normally.

To have the right company - Some animals need to have friends of their own kind. Animals should have the right sort of company and some should be kept on their own.

Good health - Animals should be protected from pain, suffering, injury and disease and should be treated by a vet if they are sick and injured.
